The Up Center remains committed to ensuring housing and financial stability for people with disabilities, including veterans, and to matching youth in our community with a caring mentor who can be a consistent and stable presence in a young person's life.

It's not unusual for a person who seeks out The Up Center for parenting support or peer counseling for substance use disorder to also use our mental health counseling services. As one of the largest private nonprofit providers of mental health services in our region, we see daily the challenges people have in accessing quality care. With your help, this year we addressed many of those barriers, and delivered 16,742 sessions of quality mental health and substance use counseling, providing transportation and childcare, and offering free or low-cost services.

Incredibly, in 2023 we will mark the 140th year of improving lives and outcomes. We look forward to inviting you to celebrate this milestone with us in the coming year and to thank you for all you do for children, families, and communities in Hampton Roads.

veterans, active duty, and military family members were able to access quality, culturally competent mental health services in our Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic.

children, including those from military connected families, were helped by therapists specializing in pediatric mental health care.

Support STABILIZATION

youth were matched with a caring adult mentor. Team Up met a yearly goal of 40 matches with three months left in the year.

people with disabilities including veterans avoided institutionalization and were stabilized in the community through The Up Center's bill paying services.

individuals with disabilities were able to live in homes with specially trained families instead of group homes or institutions.




